### LOCAL COMMUNITY ACTION PLAN IN CORBY

Blue Skies Corby have recently started to support a local homeless charities with useable surplus fruit twice a week. So far, the team have been able to support 1420 individual families in the community. The Corby Homeless Project are a 24/7 staffed provision that provides their residents with everything that they need from a toothbrush to a hot meal. They are 60% funded through housing benefits and 40% fundraising, so they do need to rely on local businesses, schools, and members of the public to come forward and help support them financially.

Additionally, we continue to support our people to resolve any problems with which they struggle with as part of our Live in the UK support scheme. This includes helping people to register at a GP, open bank accounts and resolve financial issues. A huge well done to the team for all of their dedication and support in their local community work!

#### ORGANISATION SURVEY IN BRAZIL

Blue Skies Brazil have recently completed their "Organisational Climate Survey" with their staff to try to identify points of demotivation and act internally on improvements to make people happy at Blue Skies. This ownership of their site climate and conditions in itself is excellent.
