MASTERING THE EMERGENCY DRILL!

On January 27th, an evacuation drill was conducted both during the day and at night to ensure readiness in the event of a real emergency. The drill aimed to minimize risks and damage while preparing the team to respond quickly and effectively during fire outbreaks. During the daytime drill, 377 people, including fire brigades, were evacuated in 3 minutes and 14 seconds. In the nighttime drill, 59 people, including fire brigades, were evacuated in 1 minute and 24 seconds. The evacuation was successfully completed.



FIRE BRIGADE TRAINING SESSION

The Brazil team recently participated in an external training session with the fire brigade. The training included simulated fire scenarios in outdoor areas, where participants learned to operate firefighting equipment, such as fire extinguishers, hoses, and hydrant systems. It also covered evacuation procedures, first aid, and fire prevention. This initiative highlights Blue Skies' ongoing commitment to upholding health and safety protocols for the well-being of all staff.
