

BLUE SKIES FOUNDATION EMPOWERS EDUCATION IN NSAWAM ADOAGYIRI MUNICIPALITY

In an effort to improve the learning environment in the Nsawam Adoagyiri Municipality of the Eastern Region, the Blue Skies Foundation has donated educational resources to 10 schools in the area. The initiative, mobilized by UK office staff, aims to support both teachers and students in their educational work in Ghana.

The donation included 27 laptops, 13 monitors, 1,090 exercise books, 330 children's books, and teaching materials, all of which are expected to enhance the quality of education and promote innovation in the classroom. By providing modern technology and essential supplies, the Foundation is helping to create a more supportive learning environment.

Alistair Djimatey, Manager of the Blue Skies Foundation expressed Blue Skies commitment to supporting education in underprivileged communities, stating, "We believe that every child deserves access to quality education, and we are proud to contribute to the development of these schools in the Nsawam Adoagyiri Municipality."
